

## Road to Equality Tour to Stop in Warroad

The Women's Foundation of Minnesota will hold a public meeting in Warroad to share key findings from its new research, *Status of Women & Girls in Minnesota*, and learn from residents how well the new data represents what's happening for women and girls in their community.

The event will be held on Monday, June 21, from 10:30-11:30 a.m. at the Public Safety Facility, located at 802 Cherne Drive NW (one block south of Dairy Queen). The event is free of charge.

The community presentation in Warroad is one of eight such events the Women's Foundation will convene during its statewide tour in June.

*Status of Women & Girls in Minnesota* is an ongoing collaborative research project of the Women's Foundation and the University of Minnesota's Center on Women and Public Policy. The project expands the available data on women and girls, provides ongoing trend analysis, raises public awareness and improves policy responses to the needs of women and girls in Minnesota.
